MDA Foundation Model:

The AB review version of the MDA Foundation Model is ormsc/09-02-01. It's only one word different from the Santa Clara draft, ormsc/08-12-02. (The word "purpose" was changed to "concern" in the first sentence of 2.1 to align with Figure 1.) I've asked the AB to review this draft on Monday.

We'll review comments from Monday's AB review and make edits as requested. Then we'll hold a vote to recommend our revised version to AB for endorsement.

MDA GUIDE:

With the Foundation Model complete (hopefully!), we can start work in earnest on a revised MDA Guide replacement for the original June 2003 version 1.0.1.

We probably don't want to attempt a large and total replacement all at one shot. To increase our chances of success, we probably ought to divide the task into reasonable parts, prioritize, and distribute writing chores among willing members. Then we'll finalize and ask the AB to endorse one section at a time. If you want to see a particular section written into the Guide, the best way to get your wish is to write it, or at least part of it.

HOMEWORK to prepare for this meeting: Look over the original MDA guide, document omg/03-06-01, especially the organization. Think about what's old and expendable, and what's needed and not there, and bring these suggestions to the meeting. We already know that the BPM and Business Rule folks want a section, so this next set of meetings is the time to get that and whatever else into the ORMSC's project plan.
