The ORMSC will meet in Reston from 0800 to 0900. The meeting will also be carried on our GoToMeeting link; see below or the ORMSC wiki for details.

The current version of our document, ormsc/14-01-02, is nearly complete except for individual paragraphs and links from OMG Task Forces and specification-writing SIGs describing the relation of their specifications with MDA. At this meeting, ORMSC members will insert paragraphs received and discuss how to obtain contributions from groups that haven't provided any.

In addition, members will review the document as a whole for consistency, content, and style.

The following paragraph, previously emailed to chairs, tells what ORMSC needs from each group to be inserted into the MDA Guide document:

ORMSC plans for the chapter call for inclusion of a brief summary (about 150-160 words) from each domain or (for horizontal topics) technical area, with a link to a set of web pages dedicated to MDA-based specifications in that domain or area - that is, specifications that support modeling or model-based development. The paragraph that you insert into the MDA Guide document should cover only aspects that are basic and stable; reserve the descriptions of your advancing or evolving standards for the referenced web pages which, unlike the main document, can be updated without a vote of a TC or the AB. This organization will allow readers to scan summaries of the entire range of MDA-based OMG standards in the document and follow up on their individual interests in detail on the web without requiring the ORMSC to maintain a complex, multi-subject, constantly-evolving document.
